



Funding Eligibility 2023

Funded courses are only available to applicants living in the Greater London area and who are 19 or over on 31/08/2022

Full Funded places

In addition to living in the Greater London Area to receive full funding you must either be unemployed and on benefits or earning under £21,547.50

For a fully funded place you must provide;

- Evidence of your postal address such as gas/electric bill, bank statement, universal credit letter or pay slip.

And one of the following;

- Proof of benefits dated no longer than 3 months prior to the course start date such as a universal credit letter.
- Proof of earning less than £21,547.50. which could include a pay slip or bank statements (if you do receive pay slips)

Partially Funded places

All other Greater London Area residents will receive partial funding and are required to provide the following evidence;

- Evidence of your postal address such as gas/electric bill, bank statement, universal credit letter or pay slip.
