Tuition Fees

Degree Programmes

For all degree programmes, international students are required to pay a deposit of £1,000. Once a student accepts their offer, they will receive a payment link to pay their deposit. Their deposit payment will be required 28 days from receipt.

<u>Please Note:</u> The deposit is deducted from the overall tuition fee. A full payment of the annual tuition fee is required from all international students as a condition of their offer and per their invoice.

Once their application has been reviewed students will be required to pay their tuition fees in full before the start date of their programme.

Where is the school located?

Central Film School is located in South-West London between Clapham North and Brixton. Clapham North and Clapham High Street stations are just a few minutes walk away.

How many students do you have approximately?

To guarantee the quality of learning outcome, Central Film School has small class sizes of 15 - 20 students. Students are able to get as much access to tutors and academic staff as they need to realise their potential. Average number of students per year is 150.

What is the teaching method at Central Film School?

Central Film School have highly practical programmes designed to fully equip future film professionals with the skills they will need to succeed. Our first class programmes are delivered through experienced Film Professionals. A practical and student-centred approach in small size classes ensure our students have excellent access to our Academic Team, professional equipment and facilities.

Why is the duration of your BA programmes only 2 years?

All of our BA degrees are accelerated to mirror the film industry work cycle. Programmes are split into Level 4, Level 5 and Level 6. This specialist 2 years structure includes extra terms during the Summer period and ensures that students are able to enter the professional world as soon as possible.

Who are the programmes of Central Film School accredited by?

Undergraduate and postgraduate programmes at Central Film School are fully accredited and recognised internationally - all of our degrees are validated by Falmouth University, the No.1 Arts University in the UK.
